A visit to Kurukshetra


The school organized a trip for middle classes to *Kurukshetra* on October 31, 2014. The students were accompanied by teachers.

Follow- up activities were conducted for the students which included paragraph writing and poster – making based on the trip.








Heritage Visit to Gurudwara Sri Paonta Sahib
