# Teacher's Section

## CRITICAL THINKING & PROBLEM SOLVING ATTITUDE : A SCIENTIFIC APPROACH

An important goal of education is helping students learn how to think more productively by combining creative thinking (to generate ideas) & critical thinking (to evaluate ideas). Both modes of thinking are essential for a well rounded productive thinker to carry out a work more efficiently with high productivity. These two skills are very important for a person to have a problem solving attitude.

So, having a scientific temperament towards a particular situation may help to build these skills in an individual. Science believes in generating ideas, observing, analyzing, experimenting, concluding valid results & then implementing. It is an approach which emphasizes on generating possible solutions in order to find the best one. Very often a problem persists, not because we can't tell which available solution is best, but because the best solution has not yet been made available.

A problem is not actually an unpleasant situation or a difficulty. Rather it is a question raised for inquiry, consideration or solution. It is actually a situation where you have an opportunity to make a difference, to make things better. Therefore problem solving is converting an "actual current state" into a "desired future state", by adopting valid approach makes an individual to look into the causes & solutions of a problem. It makes him to think why, how, where? ; & then to find out the solutions by generating, evaluating & experimenting the best possible solutions. So, a scientific approach helps us to decide whether, "the way we think the world is" corresponds to "the way the world really is" !

Therefore, it is pertinent that the teachers in particular should create such an environment in the schools so that pupils may act & react in such a way so that they may develop scientific temperament & scientific skills in them as well as critical thinking & problem solving attitude. It will encourage & promote them to think, understand & analyse the problems in scientific manner which in turn will result enhancement of scientific research & lead to higher growth & development of nation to make it a global example of progress.

### 4. Social Science might save our life:

Accident at work happen even in the best regulated companies that provide staff training and take all necessary precautions.

A top-down imposed safety regime simply doesn't work. It is when people see unsafe work practices as unacceptable and take decisions as teams that work places become safer. These principles have also been shown to work in Crowd Control.

### 5. Social Science gives rise in Public Intelligence:

In our fast changing world, there is a need of public intellectuals. This doesn't have to be a succession of boring grey talking heads. It means that social scientists/ public

intellectual have a duty to make their work interesting and engaging to the rest of us.

### 6. Social Science improves our children's lives and education:

All societies and all governments want to show that they are doing the best to their children. Yet education reforms seem to take place without regard for the best interests of the learners.

-Educational research shows that many parents are more concerned that their children enjoy school than that they are academic stars.

-By working with students of all ages to understand their perspective on schooling, they discovered new insights into what makes effective schooling and effective school leadership.

### 7. Social Science can change the world for better:

Social Scientists are concerned with the social and economic advancement of humanity at large. They work with government institutions, different organization, funding agencies, media etc. They are influencing the work of strategists, planners, teachers and officers in developing and growing economies like India to influence development.

### 8. Social Science broadens Horizons:

For debates about feminism, peace, ecology, social movements and much more, Social Science offers each of us new perspective and new way of understanding. Whether the idea of relaxation, visiting a museum, watching soaps or chatting online. Social Science look at our everyday activities and culture.

### 9. We need to guarantee our democracy:

Social Science offers multiple perspectives on society, influences social policy and supports us in holding our politician and media to account.

The specialized agencies are monitoring how transformation from traditional to digital media is examining the move away from traditional journalism and politics to where we as citizens try to be committed journalists, presenting our own accounts on-line.

**WHAT TO DO:** Example September 10, 1979

1. Write down the last two digits of the year you were born.- 79
2. Multiply that number by 25. Drop the decimal part of that number if there is one.  $(25 \times 79 = 19.75) 19$
3. Find the number of the month of your birthday in the Months Table. (September = 6)
4. Write the date of the month of your birthday. 10
5. Add your four answers from Steps 1 to 4. 114
6. Divide the sum you got in Step 5 by 7.  $114/7 = 16 \text{ } 2 + \text{remainder}$
7. The remainder should be a number from 0 to 6. It will be a 0 if 7 divides into the sum exactly.
8. Find the remainder in Days Table. It will tell you on which day of the week you were born. (2=Monday)
