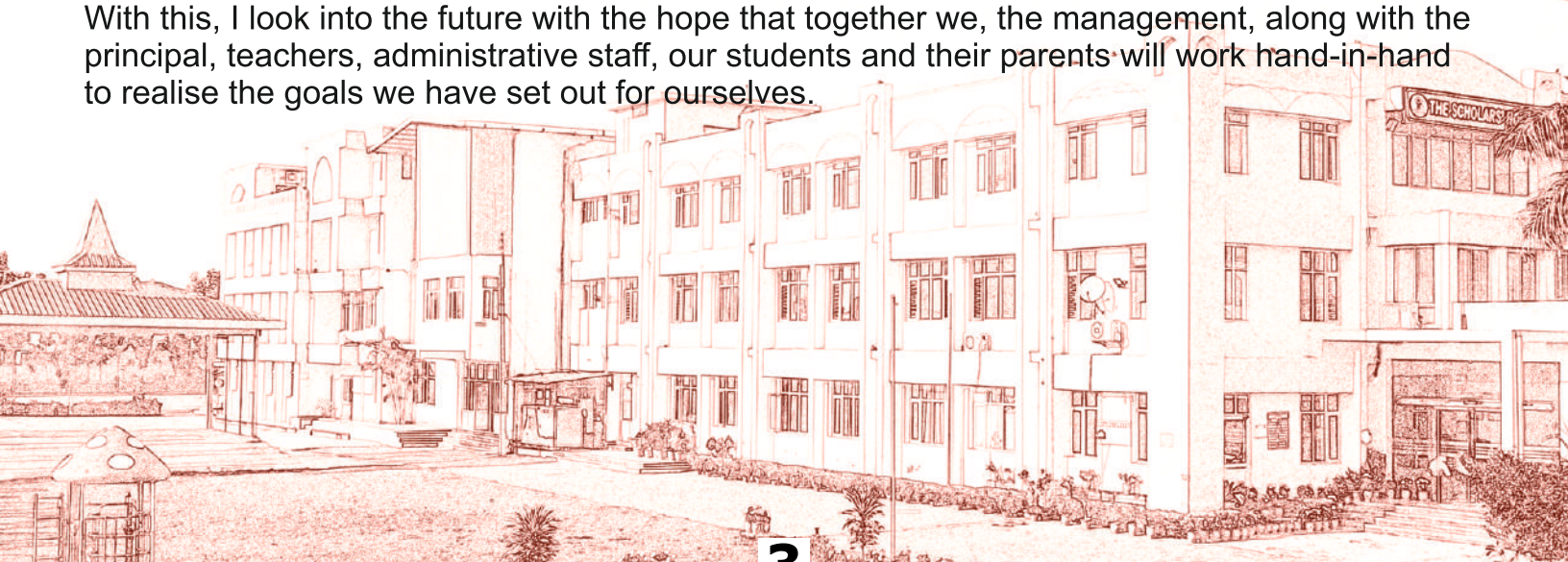
It is with this philanthropic spirit that we have drawn our educational goal of empowering our students to become self dependent and have a global outlook, albeit with a keen eye to local conditions.

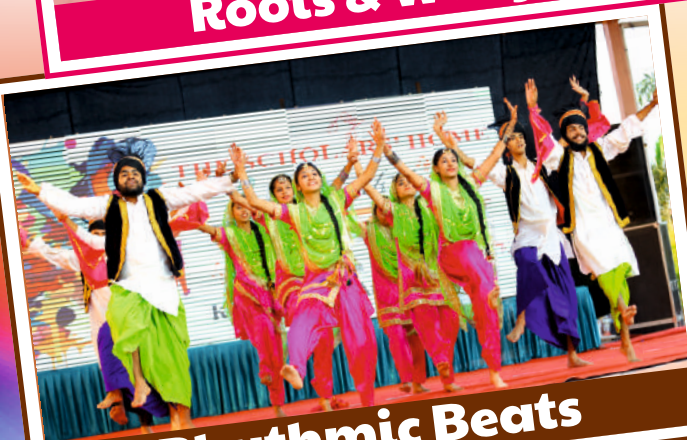

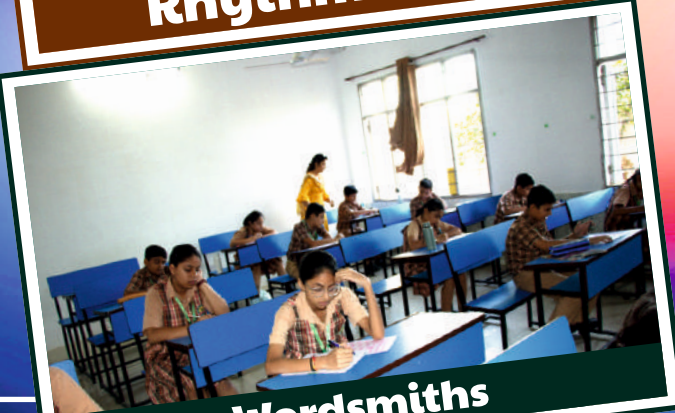

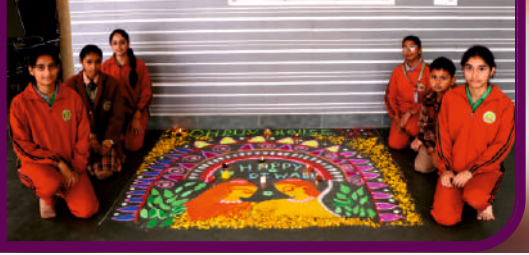

ADMISSIONS OPEN

Registration

Registration for admission opens in the second week of December for the next academic year (April to March). Registration does not mean admission.

For Pre-Nursery and Nursery classes interaction with the children [who have been registered for admission] and their parents shall be held. The date of interaction shall be intimated at the time of registration. For Classes K.G. onwards, Admission Tests shall be held (only for those children who have been registered for admission) as per the following details :-

For Class XI (Age: 16+)

- Provisional Admission is given in class XI on the basis of Final performance of class IX & Half Yearly performance of class X on clearing the Admission Test conducted by the school.
- Admission is confirmed into a regular one only if the subject wise performance criteria in class X is fulfilled in the Final Result of Class X, along with minimum 75% over all.

For Class X (Age: 15+) & XII (Age: 17+)

Usually no admissions are taken in class X & XII. But special cases are allowed.

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

- 1) Admission Form (which is given from the school only after the admission test is cleared) duly filled.
- 2) 2 coloured photographs of the child. (Passport size, Front Face, White Background)
- 3) Birth certificate issued by Municipal Committee or Panchayat & attested photocopy of the same.
- 4) Previous School's Report Card (if applicable) & attested photocopy of the same.
- 5) Transfer Certificate from the previous school.
- 6) Copy of Aadhar Card Both the Parents and the Child.
